22-3033 Reynold v Hogan - Mr. Reynolds has a medical claim, in violation of his Fourteenth Amendment Due Process rights, against certain staff members at the Christian County Jail and a Monell claim against the Jail Administrator based upon the Jail's policy of denying medication because it was too expensive. Mr. Reynolds has a sixth grade education. Defendants have filed a motion for summary judgment, and Plaintiff says that he cannot respond without the assistance of counsel.

23-4003 Holmes v Wexford - Plaintiff Montrell Holmes alleges a deliberate indifference claim in violation of his Eighth Amendment rights to his serious medical needs.

23-4011 Williams v Awada, et al. – Plaintiff Dahnyah Williams Complaint states two claims: (1) a deliberate indifference claim in violation of Plaintiff's Eighth Amendment rights against the individually named Defendants and (2) a Monell claim against Defendant Wexford Health Sources, Inc.
