MC: ...and you know, the thing is, you know, when you're exonerated, uh, there is (unintelligible), nothin' you, nothin'...they're not held liable for anything. And you know what? When this is all said and done, you know, you're exonerated, I'd love to contact their dad and say, you know, I'm ashamed of him for not insisting that they look for another suspect because you let, you know, the kidnapper of your daughter go.

BC: Yeah.

MC: Because I'm sure that he has not insisted on that. Whether he insisted or not, whether they would do it or not. But I bet ya he never did. You know, what makes him think the first suspect is the guilty party? I, I don't understand that, you know.

BC: That's...that's a good point. And that's the first time I've heard that.

MC: It, it, it's ridiculous that, you know, their family – not just the father but everyone – why are they [audible sigh]?

BC: Yeah. I...

MC: They're lettin' it happen and they're lettin' that person go.

BC: Yeah.

MC: They're lettin' the guilty party go. And, to me, they should be ashamed of themselves. And I plan on, you know, when this is all said and done to point it out to them. Each and every one of them. That they should be ashamed. They're lettin' somebody get away with this.
