Gaddy v. Wexford, 20-4181

Plaintiff Gaddy is currently incarcerated at Hill Correctional Center is ready for trial. Plaintiff alleges that Defendants (a dentist and dental assistant) ignored his constant complaints of pain for a wisdom tooth that eventually required extraction in violation of the Eighth Amendment. There is also a claim against Wexford Health Sources alleging that their policies caused the constitutional deprivation.

Pacheco v Glossip 22-4028

Plaintiff Pacheco is a detainee at the Knox County Jail. Plaintiff Pacheco has a single claim against the Defendants: an excessive force claim against the Plaintiff when he was a detainee at the Knox County Jail in violation of his Fourteenth Amendment Rights.
