Civil prisoner cases needing Pro Bono Counsel**

The Central District of Illinois Plan for Recruitment of Counsel has a cap of \$1,000.00 for reimbursement of expenses.

Williams v. Nurse, 25-1166

Plaintiff is incarcerated at Menard Correctional Center. The Plaintiff states that he has a fifth grade education and that he suffers from mental illnesses, including bi-polar, ADHD, and PTSD. He has a single claim for a violation of his Eight Amendment rights based upon the verbal harassment by a John Doe guard.

Bolden v. Orris, 24-4199

Plaintiff is a detainee at Rushville. The case is set for a jury trial on June 15. The Plaintiff has two claims that are proceeding to trial: (1) a claim of a denial of access to the court in violation of his First Amendment rights and (2) a retaliation claim in violation of his First Amendment rights. Both claims are against a single Defendant who is a security therapist aide at Rushville.

22-1120 Holcomb v. Hillard

Plaintiff is incarcerated at Pekin FCI. Plaintiff alleges deliberate indifference to his medical care, excessive force, right to be free from cruel and unusual punishment and malicious prosecution.

24-1476 Johnson v Nurse

Plaintiff is incarcerated at Menard Correctional Center. Plaintiff alleges deliberate indifference to his safety in violation of the Eighth Amendment for failure to protect.

24-3110 Scott v Green

Plaintiff is incarcerated at Centralia Correctional Center. Plaintiff states Eighth Amendment claims against Zimmerman,,Greene, and Goins based on the alleged sexualized and injurious search.

24-3243 Lyles v Clarkson

Plaintiff is incarcerated at Western Correctional Center. Plaintiff, proceeding pro se, sued under 42 U.S.C. § 1983 alleging Eighth Amendment claims stemming from his medical care at Western Illinois Correctional Center.

25-3117 Brown v Pritzker

Plaintiff is incarcerated at Western Correctional Center. Plaintiff seeks to bring claims against several defendants related to the termination of service by computer tablet provider GTL/ViaPath and the Illinois Department of Corrections, and his loss of music files and related media, in that transition process.

25-1195 Smith v Perez

Plaintiff is incarcerated at Menard Correctional Center. Plaintiff states Eighth Amendment claims for excessive force and denial of medical care, and First Amendment claims for retaliation for engaging in protected speech.
