STANDING ORDER REGARDING CONTINUANCES OF  
INITIAL PRETRIAL CONFERENCES IN CRIMINAL CASES  
SCHEDULED BEFORE JUDGE SCHANZLE-HASKINS

The following rules shall apply to any motion to continue an initial pre-trial conference in a criminal case set before U.S. Magistrate Judge Tom Schanzle-Haskins, and therefore continuance of the trial date before a U.S. District Judge:

- A. The motion shall be filed no later than two days prior to the scheduled initial pretrial conference;
- B. The motion shall state a specific case-related reason for the request;
- C. The motion shall state specifically the amount of time requested for continuance of the initial pretrial conference and trial date;
- D. The motion shall state whether the Government has any objection to the motion; (Assistant U.S. Attorneys are directed to quickly respond to defense counsel's inquiry as to objections)
- E. Separate motions shall be filed by each defendant in a multi-defendant case.
