- 1) All proposed orders submitted to Judge Myerscough, in both civil and criminal cases, should use 14-point Bookman Old Style font.
- 2) Proposed orders should be double-spaced, except that block quotations should be single-spaced.
- 3) The body text of a proposed order should be left-justified rather than fully justified across the page.
- **4)** Every sentence-ending punctuation mark in a proposed order should be followed by two spaces rather than one.
- 5) Proposed orders should not include italicized text. Instead, case names, citation signals, and any other text that would otherwise be italicized should be <u>underlined</u>.
- 6) Page numbers should be included in the bottom margin on every page of a proposed order, including page 1. The format of page numbers should be "Page X of Y".

7) Pursuant to Judge Myerscough's standing order on default judgments, every motion for default judgment submitted to Judge Myerscough must include a proposed order that complies with the requirements set forth in this standing order.
